

Who We Are: NEO-MEC is a rapidly-expanding partnership of religious congregations, health care providers, community organizations, businesses, insurers, medical professionals, consumer groups, and advocates working together to help our state expand Medicaid to all Ohioans now eligible under the Affordable Care Act.

What We Believe: Medicaid expansion is vital to our region and the state as a whole:

- 1. The health and well being of hundreds of thousands of uninsured members of our community will be greatly enhanced by access to life-saving medical coverage that Medicaid can provide.
- 2. We can better address the issue of health care "hot spots" by bringing uninsured persons onto care and into patient centered medical homes.
- 3. The economic impact of Medicaid expansion will bring tens of thousands of new jobs and millions of dollars in new tax revenue to our region.
- 4. The sustainability of our world-class health care facilities, a major centerpiece of Northeast Ohio's economy, requires adequate reimbursement for the care provided. Medicaid expansion will be an important funding source to cover our uninsured residents. The current path is unsustainable.
- 5. Ohio businesses will continue to be disadvantaged by higher health insurance premiums if we don't dramatically reduce the number of uninsured Ohioans.
